Pastor's Corner: April 2025 **Pasiors**' If anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! 18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation. -2 Corinthians 5:17-18

A few months ago, we and our friends at First Presbyterian Church of Wadesboro embarked on a new journey together: the journey of Shared Ministry. As we enter our 4th month of this undertaking, I can't help but reflect on some of the changes that have occurred since January. Not "everything old" has passed away, but there were some activities in Wadesboro had to go. Letting those things pass out of my hands gave me the chance to begin building relationships here, trying out new activities, and reflecting on how to adapt my personal ministry to suite the wider range of talents, perspectives, gifts, and needs that comes with having two churches in my care. And it is exciting to dream big and envision how we might collaborate with one another on future mission projects or special events.

Our first official collaborative event will occur on April 20 as we co-host a 7:00 AM Easter Sunrise service at the Pee Dee Wildlife Refuge. Some of our recent visitors from Albermarle have been instrumental in providing the location and music for this service. While we will still have our own Easter service with Confirmation and Communion at 9:30 AM, I hope you can join our siblings in Christ from Wadesboro at the shelter by the pond (located near the entrance just off of Rt. 52). There, we will greet the dawn and hear the news that Christ is risen. May Easter Sunrise be the first of many joint activities in the years to come-so that together, we can support one another in making things new and reconciling the world to God through Christ.

As we pursue new opportunities with FPC Wadesboro, let us continue to live into similar opportunities in our own community... for nurturing our relationships with other churches and helping organizations in our own community is just as important as our developing a deeper relationship with our friends up the road. For instance, why not attend services at First United Methodist's 6:00 PM service?

As we continue to move towards whatever new things await us next, may God bless all our endeavors—as both an individual congregation and as a people committed to collaborating with other parts of Christ's risen body on Earth. And may we rejoice in the ministries of reconciliation Christ calls us to each and every day.
